How does Self Service Direct Deposit Differ from ADP's Full Service Direct Deposit?

Full Service Direct Deposit (FSDD)	Self Service Direct Deposit (SSDD)
With FSDD, the entire Direct Deposit process is handled by ADP. You only have to close Payroll and ADP takes care of the rest of the steps.	SSDD creates the Direct Deposit (NACHA-formatted) file for you to send to your bank.
FSDD automatically executes the transfer of funds to your banks.	SSDD generates the file for your bank to execute the transfer of funds.
Because it is a full service solution in which ADP handles most aspects of the direct deposit, FSDD requires you to close three days prior to payday in order to complete the process.	Because you work directly with your bank, payroll close is determined by the bank.
With FSDD, you can deposit your employees' funds onto a TotalPay® Card, which acts as a Visa debit card and is ideal for under-banked employees.	TotalPay Card is not available with Self-Service Direct Deposit.
Requires ADP Payroll, Payroll Tax and GetWired™.	Only requires ADP DMS Payroll.
